



Mixed Media Nest Supply List by *Twyla Marti*

Thank you for signing up for my Mixed Media Nest class! This is an idea of what I am providing and what you need to bring to class. I also want to give you some “**ideas**” of what to bring.
Friday, August 16th at 10:00 am.

I am providing:

- Nest structure
- Nest Coating
- 3 blank eggs
- Old papers to cover eggs
- Wire and Beads for nest bling
- Natural raffia for initial nest bedding
- Large scissors
- Glue
- Hair Dryers for drying nests

You need to bring:

- Misc pokies - old knitting needles, paint brushes, used up pens, chop sticks, coffee stirs, etc. Note: do not use sticks from the yard unless they have been “sterilized” (voice of experience here)
- Special bedding materials/paper that you may want to cut up and weave into your nests. Also can use thin ribbons, old cassette film, anything thin that can be cut and used.
- Any special colors if you are wanting to do a “theme” like Halloween (which could be so cool), Christmas (think cardinals)..etc.
- Additional bling that you want to include like feathers, anything sparkly like shiny paper.
- Large crochet hook if you have one to help weave stuff through nest.
- Gloves - nest is wire and can be sharp until all put together.
- Needle nose pliers
- Apron - first part is a bit messy!
