Workshop: Multimedia Experimentation on Yupo


Media: If you have them: Alcohol Ink, Watercolor and Acrylic paints, posca pens, watercolor pencils, etc. In other words, bring what you have, and we will share.


Paper: Yupo paper medium weight, opaque, 11 x 14 inches, at least 4 sheets. I'll bring Yupo sheets to class you may purchase (\$2.00/sheet). Bring a few collage papers you have, thin ones are best for our projects.

Brushes: Watercolor or acrylic brushes, ½ inch and 1 inch and any others you prefer. Palette knives and wedges are also useful. Just bring what you have. Bring stamps, and stencils if you have them.

MISC: Apron, gloves, paper towels, spray bottle for water, scissors, and boards to support your Yupo papers (these should be waterproof like gator board or plexi).

Note: The most cost-effective way to buy Yupo paper is on line and by the pad. You can usually get a 10 sheet pad for around \$20. Right now (January), Cheap Joe's is running a special 20 sheets for \$20.19. Jerry's Artarama and Amazon have 10 sheets for \$21.31 and \$21.43, respectfully.
